

Thrive Online Assessment

Thrive On-line provides a way of working with children to support their emotional and social well-being and development. It can help children who have experienced or are struggling with, difficult life events to help them re-engage with life and learning.

We use Thrive-Online to assess and develop action plans for some individual children. This ensures that adults working with them understand their individual needs and are able to meet these most effectively. In order to carry out **INDIVIDUAL** assessments we require your consent. Your child will not be aware of the assessment but any actions will be discussed with you.

Personal data will be gathered relating to your child in order to carry out the THRIVE assessment and action plan, this may include contact details, date of birth and information relating to your child's learning and behaviour at school.

Your child's personal data will be assessed by individuals from the school and an automated process will assist with the action plan.

Your child's personal data and action plan may be shared with other adults and agencies supporting your child. The school will inform you and obtain your consent before sharing any personal data with agencies outside of the school.

Information gathered in the THRIVE assessment will be stored in secure computer systems and anonymous statistical information will be created. The data will be deleted in accordance with the school's retention policy.

The school will only use any personal data collected for the purposes detailed in this letter and in accordance with our privacy policy. The online tool is provided by Thrive who will process data on behalf of the school.
