## **Year 6 Residential Trip to Broadstone Warren, Forest Row, June 2026**

Next June, we are planning to take the Year 6 children to Broadstone Warren in Forest Row for 3 days from **Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> June to Friday 26<sup>th</sup> June 2026**. As you may know, residential trips organised by schools are an optional but invaluable part of the curriculum. We feel that the children benefit enormously from the experience, both educationally and socially, and we feel certain that the trip we have chosen will prove to be both enjoyable and worthwhile with plenty of opportunities for personal development, confidence building and physical exercise. We want to ensure as many children have the opportunity to take part. To make the cost more manageable, we are significantly subsidising this trip with some of our Sports Grant fund.

Broadstone Warren is run by The Scout Association and based in Ashdown Forest. They offer a full range of outdoor adventure activities in a beautiful location. Accommodation will be in comfy tents, fully catered with all food and drinks provided and the cost of the exciting activities is included.

Broadstone Warren are experienced in providing these visits and activities. Nearer the time, we will have a parent/carer meeting to discuss the trip in more detail. The cost of the 3-day trip includes: return coach travel, insurance, full board accommodation and a full programme of activities, and is **£220 per child** (based on the whole year group taking part). Payments for the trip are to be made via your online ParentPay account. You can pay in full or in instalments, as set out below:

<b>Deposit/First payment</b>	<b>£60</b>	<b><u>on or before Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2025</u></b>
<b>Second Payment</b>	<b>£80</b>	<b><u>on or before Friday 6<sup>th</sup> February 2026</u></b>
<b>Third Payment</b>	<b>£80</b>	<b><u>on or before Friday 1<sup>st</sup> May 2026</u></b>

To confirm your booking, **an initial deposit of £60** is required by all by Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2025.

**\*If you are in receipt of benefits-related, pupil premium support we are able to provide some support for the cost of this trip. Please contact me in confidence before Friday 26<sup>th</sup> September 2025. Please note that the deposit for £60 would still need to be paid on 3<sup>rd</sup> October to enable to secure your child'**

**Please note that once your non-refundable deposit has been paid, Broadstone Warren will levy a cancellation charge if you withdraw your child from the visit. In exceptional medical circumstances parents may be able to make a claim for reimbursement of part of the trip, (except the deposit) under the terms of the insurance policy.**
