

Reading

In Whole Class Reading we will:

- Read 'Ellie and the Cat'.
- Make predictions
- Retrieve information
- Make inferences about characters.

Writing

In writing we will:

- Look at what makes a sentence.
- Practise punctuating our sentences correctly.
- Look at nouns and adjectives.
- Learn about alliteration.

Science

In science we will:

- Discover the basic parts of the human body
- Learn about each of the 5 senses.

Geography

In geography we will:

- Look at the months of the year and seasons.
- Understand the differences between seasons.
- Identify the different types of weather.

Art

In art we will:

- Explore mono printing
- Make observational drawings
- Look at artists who use mono printing.

Music

In music we will:

- Learn to sing from memory.
- Be playing instruments in time to a beat.

RE

In RE we will:

- Learn about the fundamental beliefs of Christians.

PSHE

In PSHE we will:

- Look at recognising emotions.
- Learn how to work with others.
- Understand what makes a healthy friendship.
- Look at how to resolve friendship problems.

PE

In PE we will:

- Develop and apply footwork and one leg balance through focused sessions.
- Explore different ways to travel.

In computing we will:

- Identify what technology is and how it helps us.
- Online safety.

Weather

Year 1 Phonics

- Revisiting digraphs from the initial code: ck, ng, ch, sh, th, wh
- Segmenting and blending sounds to make words.
- Introducing new vowel digraphs from the extended code: ai, ee.
- Learning strategies for reading and writing polysyllabic words.

Year 2 Phonics

- Recapping code taught in Year 1
- Segmenting words and blending sounds to make words.
- Continuing learning the Extended code and looking at more alternative spellings for taught sounds.
- Learning strategies for reading and writing polysyllabic words.

Year 1 Maths

We will be looking at place value:

- Counting forwards and backwards from any number.
- Subitising
- Ordering numbers
- Looking at finding one more
- Looking at finding one less
- Using the language; more than, fewer than
- Learning about ordinal numbers
- Understanding 0
- Finding missing numbers
- Comparing numbers.

Year 2 Maths

We will :

- Represent multiples of 10 using their numerals and names.
- Add and subtract multiples of 10.
- Solve problems involving multiples of 10 in a range of contexts.
- Represent numbers 20-99 in different ways.
- Use a number line to position and estimate numbers 20-99.
- Count large numbers of objects using tens and ones.
- Compare, order and partition 2-digit numbers.
- Develop our number fluency.
