We will:

- Read 'Hotel Flamingo' by Alex Milway.
- We will make predictions, retrieve information and make inferences about characters.

Art

We will:

- Look at land art and artists who use natural objects.
- Go into our environment to compose our own land art.
- Use a range of drawing techniques.
- Make wax resist pictures.

Music

We will:

- Chant musically.
- Read crotchet, quaver, crotchet rest from stick notation.

Computing

We will:

- Use Bee-Bots to learn how to program a robot.
- Study online safety.

Geography

We will:

- Learn about the countries of the UK.
- Find out the capitals of each country in the UK.
- Look at human and physical features of the UK.

Science

We will:

- Look at what makes something alive.
- Learn about habitats and micro habitats.
- Look at food chains.
- Find out about carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.

RE

We will:

- Learn about Islam including who the Prophet Muhammed is, and why he is important to Muslims.
- Explore how Muslims pray, and why it is important to them.

PE

We will:

- Develop and apply their dynamic balances and stance through skill development.
- Use shapes and circles to create sequences of movement with a partner.

Writing

We will:

- Write descriptive narratives based on the story 'Fergal is Fuming!'.
- Write instructions based on the text 'The Disgusting Sandwich'.

PSHE

We will:

- Learn about keeping safe inside and outside school.
- Learn about road safety and how to stay safe when crossing roads.
- Learn how to keep my body safe.

Year 1 Phonics

- Revisiting digraphs from the initial code: ck, ng, ch, sh, th, wh
- Revisiting extended code learning from last term ai, ee, oa, e, er, ow
- Segmenting and blending sounds to make words.
- Introducing new vowel digraphs from the extended code: oo (moon), ie and oo (book)
- Learning strategies for reading and writing polysyllabic words.

Year 1 Maths

Place Value:

- Understand numbers to 20.
- Find 1 more or 1 less than a given number.
- Learn how to use a number line and estimate where numbers are located on a number line.
- Compare and order numbers to 20.

Addition and subtraction:

- Add by counting on.
- Add ones using number bonds.
- Explore doubles and near doubles.
- Look at a range of subtraction methods.

Year 2 Phonics

- Recapping code taught in Year 1
- Segmenting words and blending sounds to make words.
- Continuing learning the Extended code and looking at more alternative spellings for taught sounds.
- Learning strategies for reading and writing polysyllabic words.

Year 2 Maths

Money:

- Count money in pence and pounds.
- Compare amounts of money.
- Calculate with money.
- Find change.

Multiplication and division:

- Make and add equal groups.
- Use arrays.
- Group and share (division).
- Look at doubling and halving
- Learn odd and even numbers.
- Learn our 2, 5 and 10 times tables.
