Choose 2 tasks off the grid to have completed by the end of this half term.

Book Cover Remake - Re-design the cover of a favourite book using drawings, collage, paint, or mixed media. It can be any size from A5 to poster-sized.

Write us a classic book review of something that you have read recently. Include a summary of the plot, your favourite part/characters, a star rating and why you would recommend it.

Gathering data - Look around your home and create a tally chart of the different types of books you have. You could do different genres of novel (fantasy, comedy etc) or different genres of book (factual, recipe, novel, poetry). Then, turn your data into a bar chart or a pie chart.

Take one of your favourite scenes from a story and turn it into a comic strip. Think about how you can use speech and thought bubbles to bring your scene to life.

Choose a favourite book and write a diary entry from one of the character's perspectives. Try to pick a key moment in the story for them to write about. For example: Amari's first day at the bureau.

Teach the Class Page
Create a one-page "teaching sheet" that explains the topic in a non-fiction book in simple terms for younger students. Add illustrations and definitions of words they might not understand.

Choose a setting from a favourite book and draw a map of it. Try to add labels if you want to. Alternatively, do a map of all of the settings referenced in the book.

Using a non-fiction book, create some top trump cards based on the key topic in the book (for example: sportspeople, instruments, animals). Try to make 4-8 cards.

Book Spine Poetry - Stack books to create "poems" from the titles. Take a photograph and bring it in for us to see. Alternatively, write a poem using the book titles: you could handwrite this or type it up.
