

Reading

In Whole Class Reading we will be reading "My Mum is a Spy" by Andy McNab:

- Make predictions
- Retrieve information
- Make inferences about characters.

History

In history we will:

- Looking at the Great Fire of London and how it started.
- Understanding what London was like in 1666.
- Finding out how and why the fire spread.

PSHE

In PSHE we will:

- Explore differences.
- Understand the range of groups people belong to.
- Learn about the roles people have in society.
- Understand ways to look after the school environment.

Writing

In writing we will:

- Use adjectives and expanded noun phrases.
- Write instructions.
- Learn about a range of sentence structures.
- Explore poetry through the book 'Lots'.

DT

In DT we will:

- Thread a needle.
- Make a series of stitches.
- Follow the pattern of a line when stitching.

PE

In PE we will:

- Use sequences and paired work to learn and create a dance.
- Developing my ball chasing skills and knowledge

Music

In music we will:

- Learn to sing from memory.
- Be playing instruments in time to a beat.

Science

In science we will:

- Learn about habitats.
- Explore different habitats from around the world.
- Understand the rainforest and its current problems.

RE

In RE we will:

- Looking at the Easter story, including stories of the Holy Week.

In computing we will:

- Learn about grouping data and information.
- Online safety.

The Great Fire of London

Year 1 Phonics

- Revisiting extended code sounds.
- Segmenting and blending sounds to make words.
- Introducing new phonemes from the extended code: u, ar, s, l
- Learning strategies for reading and writing polysyllabic words.

Year 2 Phonics

- Recapping code taught in Year 1
- Segmenting words and blending sounds to make words.
- Continuing learning the Extended code and looking at more alternative spellings for taught sounds.
- Learning strategies for reading and writing polysyllabic words.

Year 1 Maths

We will be looking at place value:

- Counting from 20 to 50.
- Looking at the multiples of 10 to 50.
- Groups of tens and ones.
- Partitioning tens and ones.
- The number line to 50.
- Estimating numbers on a number line.
- One more.
- One less.
- Starting to look at measurement.

Year 2 Maths

We will :

- Learn to multiply and divide using the 2, 5 and 10 times table.
- Learn different methods to multiply and divide, including arrays, number lines, grouping and sharing.
- Learn to measure and compare length and height in centimetres and metres.
- Measure and compare mass, capacity and temperature.
